A new, pre-cut, factory-finished, notched Calla® ceiling panel has been designed to eliminate field modified panels. The USAI® Lighting CONNECT family of downlights have been designed and precision-engineered for seamless compatibility with the Armstrong® Ceilings Intersection Downlighting kit.

Seismic code compliant for D, E, and F areas, the new pre-engineered system replaces inconsistent field-modified finishes and edge details with clean, crisp panels and grid for a fast and easy installation. Additionally, tested for quality and efficiency, the Intersection Downlighting solution delivers a full family of high-performance LED lighting.

This combination of sound absorption and sound blocking in the same ceiling panel allows for the best noise control, while assuring flexibility for future use.
